

Position: Executive Board - President-Elect
Term: One (1) Year
Tenure: Can serve up to three (3) consecutive terms, assuming the President-Elect, President, and Past President as one (1) term
Updated: January-11

- 1) This position attends every monthly Board meeting. A minimum of nine (9) are required per year. If, for any reason, she cannot attend the Board meeting, she should pass on any pertinent information to another Board member to bring to the meeting.
- 2) This position is asked to promote WLN, support and encourage members of the Board, committee members, and the entire WLN organization. She should attend as many WLN functions as possible.
- 3) The President-Elect works to gain a better understanding of the responsibilities of the President in preparation for assuming that role. It is also important to gain an understanding of the responsibilities and activities of each of the directors and their committees.
- 4) The President-Elect assists the President and all Board members as requested.
- 5) The President-Elect, along with the President, will nominate a new President-Elect.
- 6) The President-Elect, at the end of her term, will serve on the Executive Board for one year as President.
- 7) The President-Elect is responsible for purchasing a gift from the entire Board for the outgoing President.
- 8) The President-Elect shall serve on the Committee for the Women of Achievement.
- 9) If the current President is unable to fulfill her duties during her term, the President-Elect will assume the remainder of the President's term, as well as her own term.
- 10) At the end of her term of office, this position will turn over all documents, files, etc, pertaining to her office to her successor. She will be available to answer questions during a transition period (up to 3 months).
